Working Conditions:	<p>Work is primarily oilfield related, which normally requires travel to the Customers' work sites. An employee may be required to work away from home for a scheduled period of time. TOMCO pays most of the costs incurred for this including travel, hotels or work camps, and meals. Employees may be required to work shift work and weekends.</p> <p>Employees must adhere to strict safety policies and procedures at all times to ensure the safety of everyone on the job site. Safety tickets are required, and periodic drug testing may be required as per industry standards.</p>
Training & Tickets:	<p>Employees should be a certified Field Heat Treatment Technician and must have related experience in all aspects of metal heat treatment including pre-heat and post weld heat treating and bakeouts.</p> <p>Safety tickets include: H2S - Fall Protection - TDG - WHMIS - First Aid - Confined Space - CSTS</p> <p>Employees must also hold a valid driver's license with a clean abstract.</p>
Skills Required:	<p>To be successful in their trade, our PWHT Technicians must be knowledgeable on the affect of heat on materials, the use, maintenance and repair of heat treatment equipment, codes, standards and specifications for heat treating materials, safety, occupational legislation, hazardous materials legislations applicable to their assigned tasks and the site they are working. They must also perform lifting, physical labour, work independently as well as part of a team, take direction from supervisors, have basic computer knowledge, neat, accurate paperwork.</p>
Type of Work:	<p>Employees will travel to customer pipelines and facilities where the work of pre-heating and post weld heat treating and/or bakeouts will be completed as required, as per company procedures.</p> <p>Employees will be cross-trained in a variety of oilfield specialty services which may include: cold pipe cutting and beveling - hydrotesting - isolations - controlled bolting – machining - PWHT</p>
